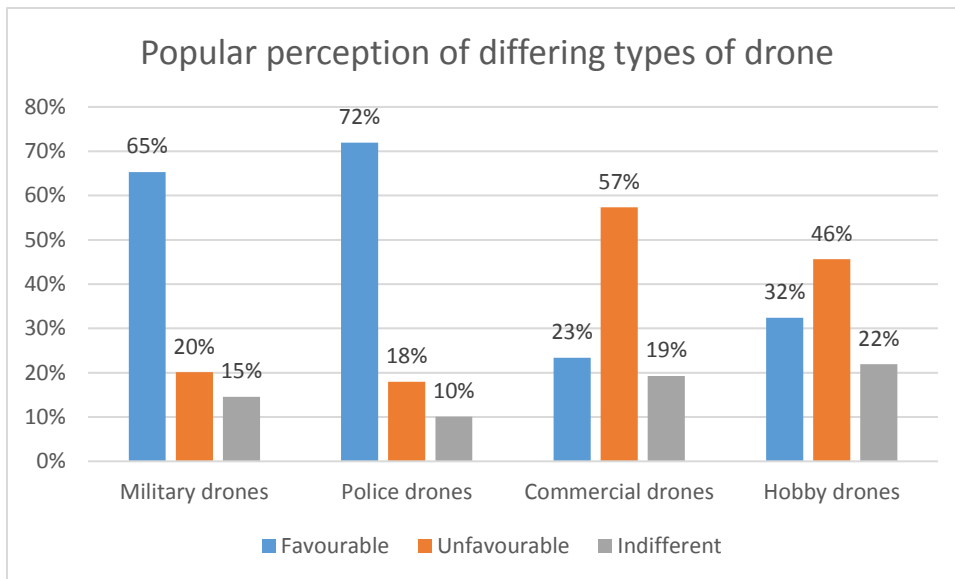


Fig. 1: Popular perception of differing types of drone

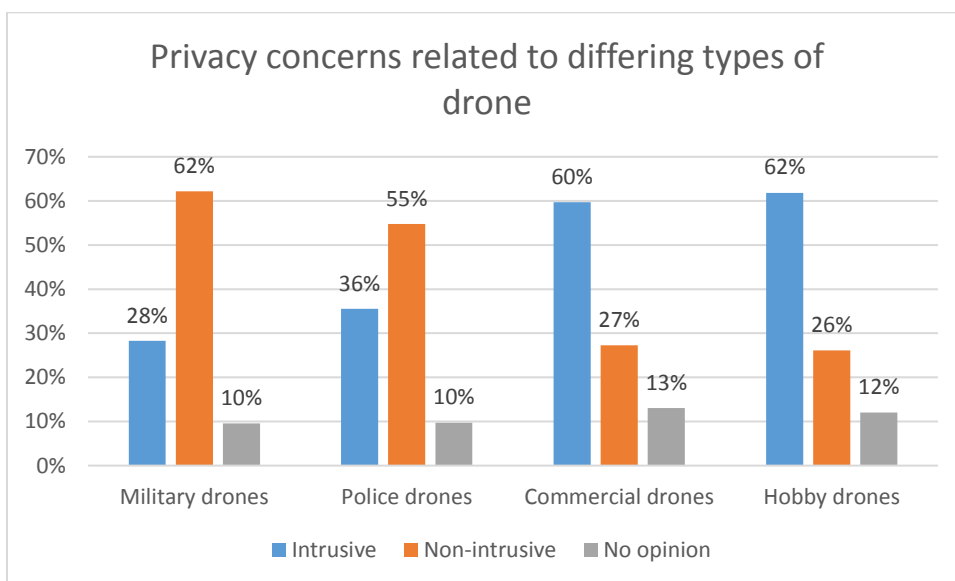


Fig. 2: Privacy concerns related to differing types of drone

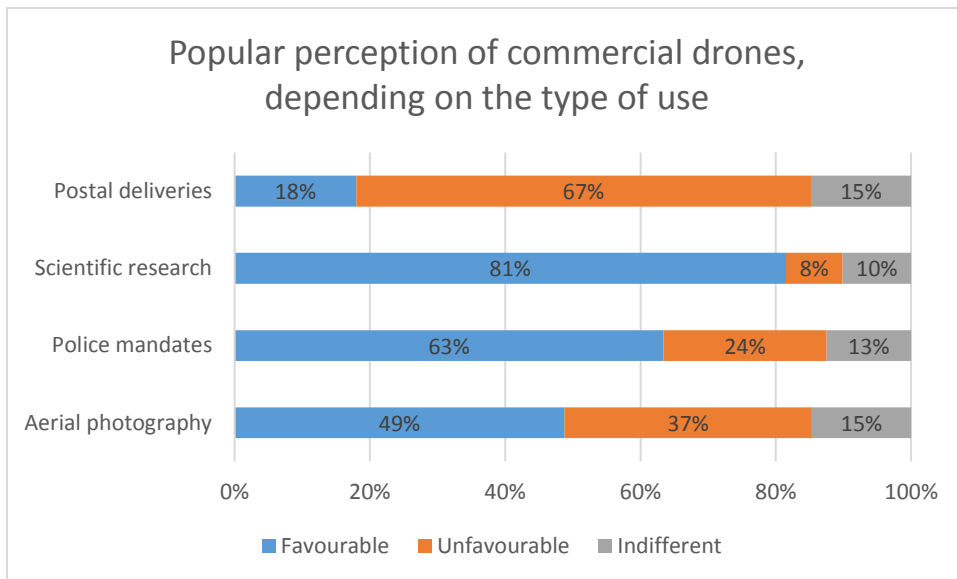


Fig. 3: Popular perception of commercial drones, depending on the type of use

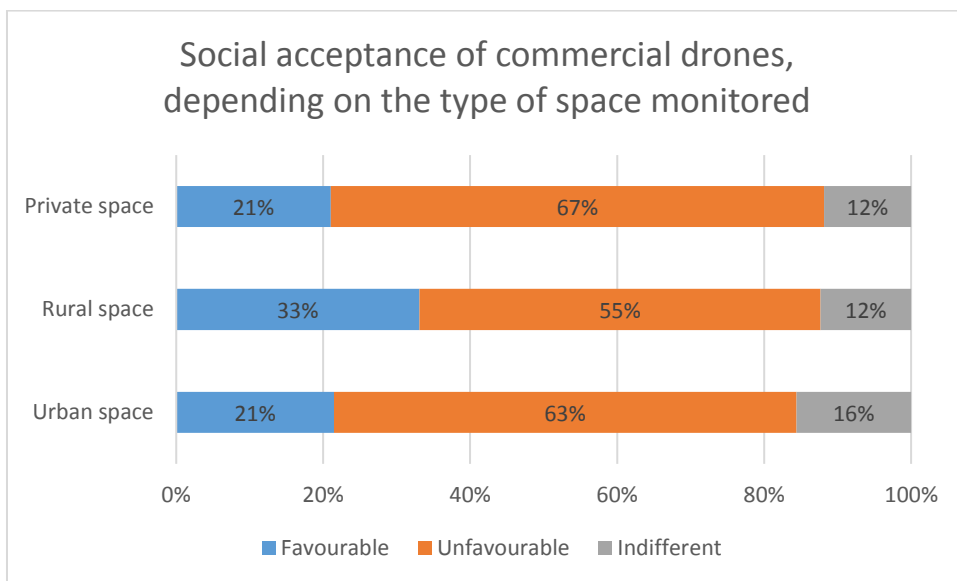


Fig. 4: Social acceptance of commercial drones, depending on the type of space monitored

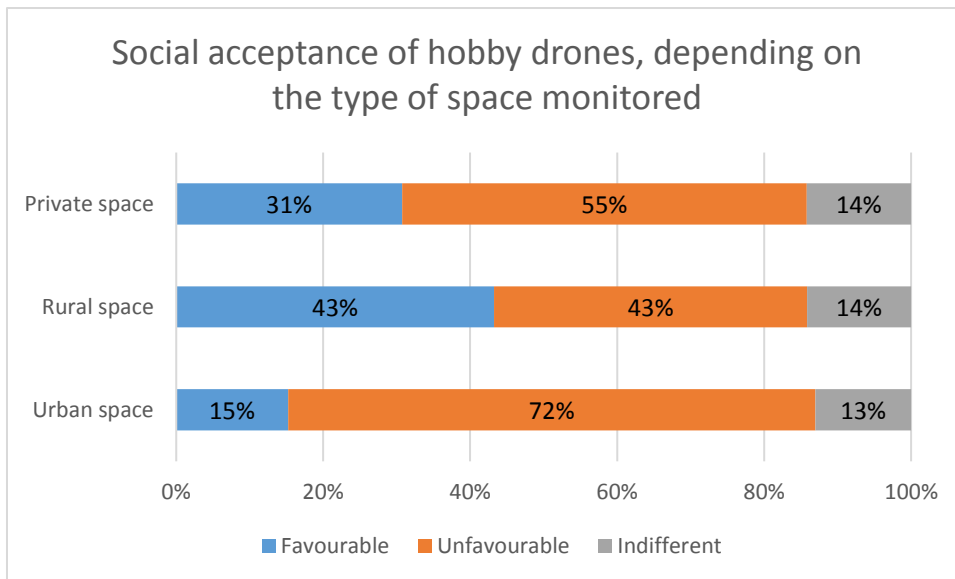


Fig. 5: Social acceptance of hobby drones, depending on the type of space monitored

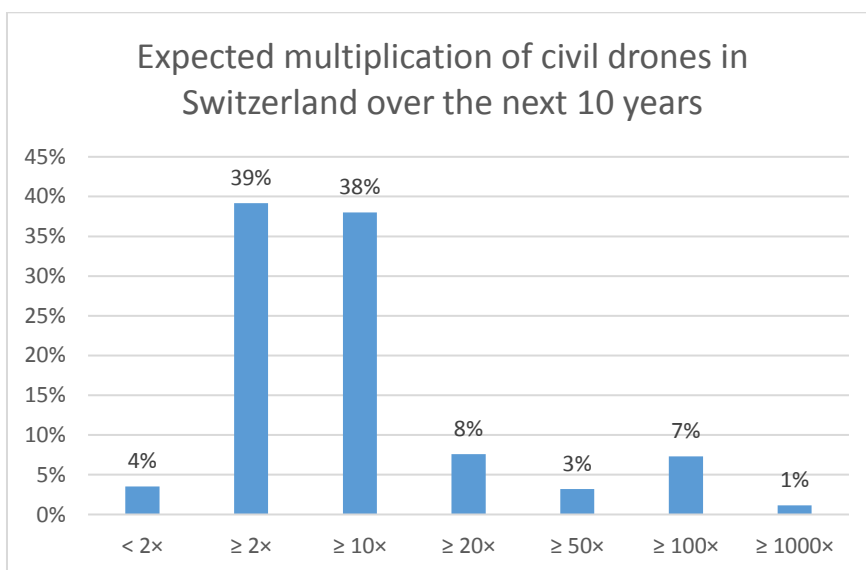


Fig. 5: Expected evolution of civil drones in Switzerland over the next 10 years
