

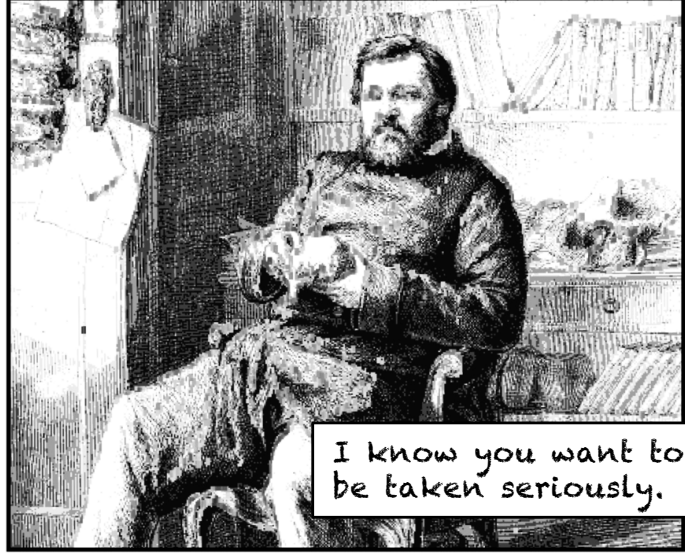

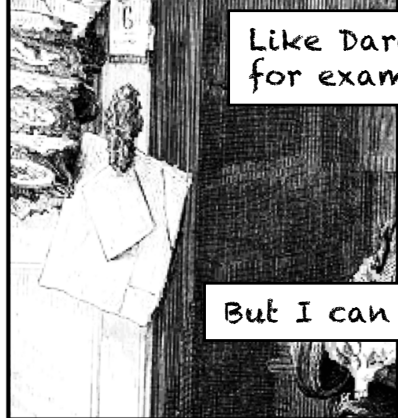

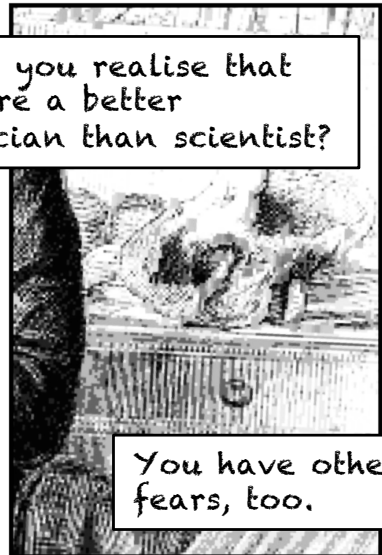


Like Darwin, for example.



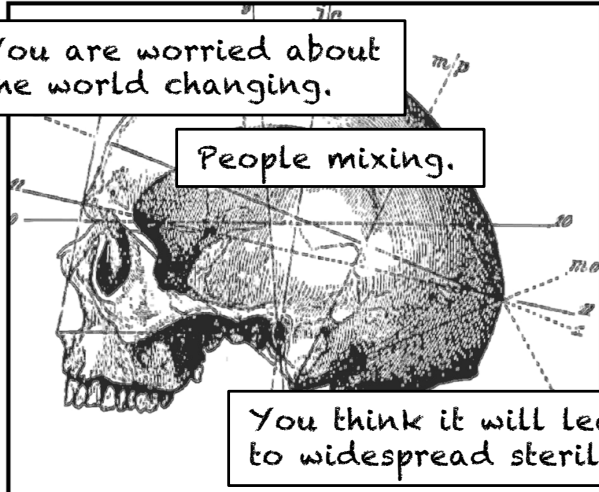
Maybe you realise that you are a better politician than scientist?

You have other fears, too.

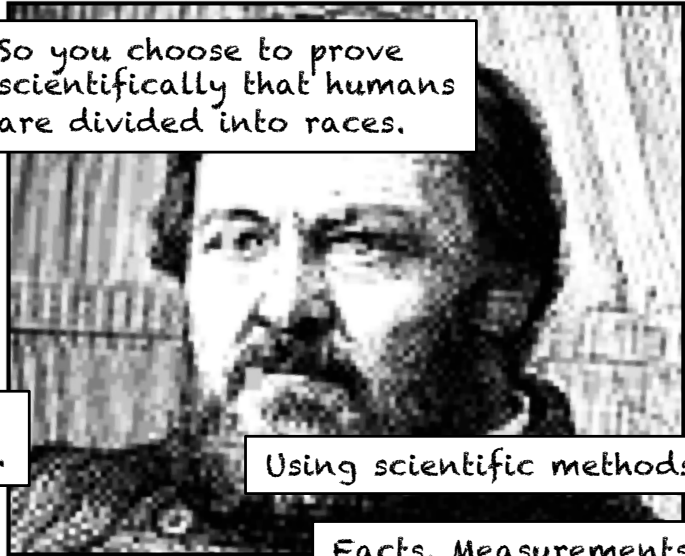
You are worried about the world changing.
